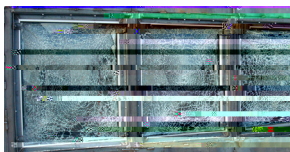


FIGURE 1. GSA performance conditions



DEFINITIONS:

Performance Condition: The performance condition is a number or number/letter combination based on several criteria including breach and distance of glass fragments in the chamber post blast.

Daylight (DL): An applied film covering only the daylight / vision area of the opening with no anchoring system applied.

Anchoring system: An anchoring system utilizing metal profiles applied along the perimeter with fasteners securing the film to the frame. In some cases, total perimeter application is not required. This system is typically used to mitigate pressures above 8 psi (55 kPa).
